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# Cultivars

## White wines

### CAP CLASSIQUE

Suitable for any time of the day, there's always an excuse for a celebration! Champagne is derived from France where the original "Bubbles" came from, known as Cap Classique in SA. Delicious shortcake flavours with hints of fruitiness on the nose & a dry finish. Cap Classique may be made from three grape varieties: Chardonnay, Pinot Noir & Pinot Meunier. Cap Classique produced traditionally, undergoes a second fermentation, where sugar & yeast are added to the bottled wines, then resealed. Carbon dioxide is trapped inside the wine under pressure & is released as bubbles "mouse," when the Cap Classique is served.

Both wines rely on the traditional French fermenting process, which is labour intensive, time consuming and entirely reliant on handpicking only the best grapes to ensure exceptional quality and optimal purity of fruit.

This is what makes them so sought after and valuable. Cap Classique is South Africa's bubble equivalent to champagne.

**Brut** – Sparkling Wine that is dry or dryish in taste.

**Blanc de Blancs** – "White of Whites"; White wine made from only white grapes.

**Demi-Sec** – Fully Sweet

### SPARKLING WINE

You can spot the difference between the two if you look closely at their bubbles; a Cap Classique will have tiny bubbles with refined effervescence while Sparkling Wine has a larger, coarser fizz. Sparkling wine by comparison is created by a process which uses artificial carbonation on the production line resulting in a distinctly different drinking enjoyment.

### SAUVIGNON BLANC

Translated to "wild white," Sauvignon Blanc is the most popular white cultivar in SA. Distinct regionally-based styles. From Darling there are dusty, green peppers but a flinty minerality creeps in as you move south through Durbanville & Constantia to Agulhas where it becomes seashells & ozone. In Stellenbosch & Robertson, a rich tropical fruit is never far from the surface.

Should one of the blend partners be less than 20% of total composition, all the blend partners % of total composition must be supplied.

Muscat grapes & wines almost always have a pronounced sweet floral aroma.

### STRAW WINE

Straw wine, or raisin wine, is a wine made from grapes that have been dried to concentrate their juice. Straw wines are typically sweet to very sweet white wines, similar in density and sweetness to Sauternes but potentially sweeter. They are capable of long ageing. An older process and suitable for warm climates. Under the classic method, after a careful hand harvest, selected bunches of ripe grapes will be laid out on mats in full sun. Under less labour-intensive versions of the technique, easily portable racks might be used instead of mats or nets, or the grapes are left lying on the ground beneath the vines, or even left hanging on the vine with the vine-arm cut or the stem twisted. Technically speaking the grapes must be cut off from the vine in order for the wine to be a 'straw wine'.

**Rosé** - Pink in colour. Mostly made from red grapes whose skins are left on the must during fermentation. The juice is then run off the skins & treated the same way as white wine. Rosé can be dry to semi-sweet and vary greatly in the level of residual sugar.

### PINOTAGE

#### CELEBRATING 100 YEARS

Locally bred cultivar, developed from a cross of Pinot Noir & Hermitage by viticulturist Professor Abraham Izak Perold in 1925. The first bottles appeared in 1961. It is a light to medium-bodied wine, unique to SA! In the early 1990s, as Apartheid ended & the world's wine market was opening up, SA winemakers ignored Pinotage in favour of more internationally recognized varieties like Shiraz. Towards the end of the 20th century, the grape's fortunes turned & by 1997 it commanded higher prices than any other SA grapes.

### CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Liveliness in the mouth & a degree of richness, yet usually finishes with firm astringency. Blackcurrant flavour with a hint of mint & cedar. King of the "Noble" grapes, famous for its use in a Bordeaux Blend. It develops well with age into spicy, full, complex wines.

### GRENACHE NOIR

Wines made from Grenache tend to lack acid, tannin and color, and it is often blended with other varieties such as Syrah, Carignan, Tempranillo and Cinsaut. Grenache is the dominant variety in most Southern Rhône wines, especially in Châteauneuf-du-Pape where it is typically over 80% of the blend.

### SANGIOVESE

Is a red Italian wine grape variety whose name derives from the Latin Sangius Jovis, "The blood of love". Young Sangiovese has fresh fruity flavours of strawberry and a little spiciness, but it readily takes on oaky, even tarry flavours when aged in barrels. Sangiovese was already well known by the 16th century.

### MERLOT

Grapes are identified by their loose bunches of large berries. The colour has less of a blue/black hue than Cabernet Sauvignon grapes, a thinner skin & fewer tannins. In food & wine pairings, the diversity of Merlot can lend itself to a wide array of matching options. Slightly herbaceous overall in both aroma & taste.

### MALBEC

Malbec grapes tend to have an inky dark colour and robust tannins. It is a thin-skinned grape and needs more sun & heat than either Merlot or Cabernet Sauvignon to mature. Malbec is known as one of the 5 cultivars to make a Bordeaux blend. It is increasingly celebrated as an Argentinian varietal wine and is being grown around the world.

# Old Vine Project



Wines that are made from old vines (vines that are 35 years and older) are a tribute to the grower's love of the land. They exist because of the people who touched and tended them over many years.

They reflect the terroir, landscape, and people who lovingly tend these vineyards across the Cape providing us with a more textural finish. Producers can certify old vine vineyards and wines with the Old Vine Project (OVP) and apply Certified Heritage Vineyard seals to their wine bottles, identifying the planting date of the vineyard from which the wine was made.

The vineyards are verified from South African Wine Industry Information System's (SAWIS) extraordinary vineyard database that dates back to 1900.

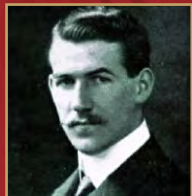

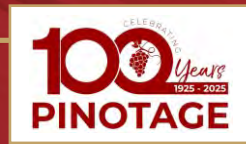
